

BABY FEET APPLIQUE INSTRUCTIONS



Our Large Baby Feet Applique is made in 2 hooping's - joined easily in-the-hoop like a jig-saw.

We have included the generic It's a Boy, It's a Girl designs.

The instructions show you where to add your own names/designs, for a personalised Gift

Once completed, you can use as a cute Wall Hanging, or, add to a Nappy bag, or Fleece Blanket for a very unique Baby

MATERIALS TO MAKE THE BUNNY

- Wash away Stabiliser (Fabric Vilene type not Solvy)
- Pellon/thin batting
- Bobbin Thread to match top thread, if you want a completely reversible Wall Hanging

Fabric Usage is dependent on your hoop size

	5x7	6x10
Pellon and Backing	Two 5x7 pieces	Two 6x10 pieces
Feet Fabric (Front and Back)	Four 5x7 pieces	Four 6x10 pieces

EMBROIDERY – YOU MUST STITCH EACH DESIGN IN ORDER



Load BF-01 to your machine

Hoop 2 layers of Water Soluble Stabiliser

Thread machine with a neutral color

Stitch Color 1 which is a guideline for placing your fabric and pellow



Place your pellow piece, then Foot Fabric over the Guidelines

Stitch Color 2 which attaches the pellow and fabric



Change thread to the Color you want for the Stippling

Stitch Color 3 - Stippling

(Skip color if you do not want the stippling)



Change thread to Color you want for lettering

(This is where you can add your own designs/wording/names)

Stitch Color 4



Remove your hoop from the machine and as pictured, use small pieces of tape to hold the backing fabric in place.

Return hoop to machine and stitch Color 5 which attaches the backing fabric



Remove hoop from machine and using sharp scissors cut away excess fabric and pella around the Feet on the front and back of design



Return hoop to machine and complete embroidery:



Change thread to Color you want for satin stitch edge

Color 6 - Zig Zags Then Satin Stitch edge of Foot



Segment 1 completed

Remove from hoop and cut away excess stabiliser – Take some care at this stage to neaten up the side edge of the Foot that will be joined – this makes it easier to join, and ensures a professional look.

Load BF-02 to your machine and as before:

- Hoop Water Soluble Stabiliser
- Thread machine with a neutral color



- Stitch Color 1 which is a guideline for placing your pellow, AND FOOT FABRIC
- Place your layer of pellow and Foot fabric over the stitched guidelines
- Stitch Color 2 which attaches the pellow and Foot fabric

Exactly as before, complete embroidery:

- Color 3 Stippling

- Color 4 Wording
- (Add your own design/wording here)
- Remove from hoop and add backing fabric
- Return to hoop – Stitch Color 5 to attach backing



As before, remove hoop from machine and using sharp scissors cut away excess fabric around the Bunny on the front and back of design



Return hoop to machine and continuing with thread you want for edges

Stitch Color 4 which zig zags edges, and stops machine where you will join Segment One



Place Segment 1 against current design as pictured.

They should butt together nicely like a jig saw puzzle – if they don't (unlikely), take the time now to cut nice and closely to the stitching, so they do fit together

SLOW YOUR MACHINE DOWN

Stitch Color 5 which joins the 2 pieces

If (unlikely) the zig zag hasn't completely attached the two sides, re-do Color 5 again until you are happy



Complete Segment 2

Color 6 - Satin Stitch Outline



Remove from hoop

Cut away excess stabiliser
Use a Q-Tip and warm water to remove stabiliser around the edges.

You do not need to completely wash the stabiliser out

While this is a fairly simple Large Applique Design, we hope it shows you how easy the larger applique designs work, and gives you the confidence to try our other Large Applique Designs – the same technique can make much larger designs.
