

BUNNY MUGRUG INSTRUCTIONS



This set includes:

*Bunny Mugrug Designs
In 3 sizes*

*Finished size - just under 5x5 inch
6x6 inch
8x8 inch*

Create these simple Coasters completely in-the-hoop – no hand sewing required.

The 'white space' is the perfect spot for you to add your own Monogram, wording or inspiration for a personal Gift.

MATERIALS TO MAKE MUG RUG

- Tear- away Stabiliser to fit hoop

	8x8 Coaster	6x6 coaster	5x5 coaster
Inner Block (white)	7x inch square	6x6 inch square	5x5 inch square
Pellon/Batting	9 x 9-inch square	7x7 inch square	6x6 inch square
Edge Fabric	9 x 9-inch square	7x7 inch square	6x6 inch square
Backing Fabric	Two 12 x9 inch panels	Two 10 x7 inch panels	Two 8x6 inch panels

PREPARATION



Before you start, fold your two Backing Pieces in half, so you have

5X5 Design - two 4 by 6 inch pieces

6x6 Design - two 5 by 7 inch pieces

8x8 Design - two 6 by 9 inch pieces



Load design to your machine

Hoop Tear-away Stabiliser

Thread machine with the color you will be using for the quilting (we used purple so you can see)

Stitch Color 1 which is a guideline for placing your Outer block fabric and pellow

Place your pellow, then Outer fabric piece over the Guideline

Stitch Color 2 which attaches the fabric and pellow and stitches a guideline for your Inner Fabric





Place your inner fabric over the Guidelines, and stitch Color 3 to attach

Change thread to the Color you want for the Stippling (We used White)

Stitch Color 4 – Stippling

**If you do not want stippling, simply skip Color 4



Remove hoop from Machine

With sharp scissors, cut away the excess White Fabric

Complete Embroidery

Stitch Color 6 – White of eyes

Stitch Color 7 – Black of eyes



ADD BACKING

Fold your two backing pieces in half and press (wrong sides together)



As pictured, place your first folded pieces of backing fabric over the top of the Mug Rug Guidelines, with folded edges towards middle

Place 2nd piece of Backing Fabric over the top of the Guidelines

Again, place folded edge towards middle, and overlapping the first Backing Piece



Stitch last Color which stitches it all together

Take care when stitching the overlap – either watch carefully and hold in place, or you can place a piece of tape over the folded edge.

Remove from hoop and cutaway the excess stabiliser/pellon and fabric – Leave about a ¼ inch seam allowance





Clip edges as pictured.

Turn to right side and Press



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
