

## IN-THE-HOOP CRAZY PATCH MUG RUG




- This Mug Rug is so quick to make in the hoop, but it looks like you have spent a long time stitching!!
- No additional Sewing is required
- A quick treat to make for yourself, or a gift for a friend.
- Includes the 26 Alphabet files for personalisation

MATERIALS	
Top Patch fabric (1)	4x8 inch scrap
Left Hand Patch (2)	6x6 inch scrap
Right Hand Patch (3)	5x6 inch scrap
Pellon/Thin Backing	5.5 by 7.5 inch
Backing Fabric	One 8X10 piece – folded in half 8X5
	One 8x6 piece – folded in half 8X3

## PREPARATION

Fold Backing Fabric in half and press, so you have

- One 8x5 inch panel with folded top edge
- One 8x3 panel with folded edge

		<p>Hoop Tear-away Stabiliser</p> <p>Thread machine with a neutral thread</p>
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	<p>Stitch Color 1 which is the placement line for the Mug Rug</p> <p>Place your pellaon/thin batting fabric over the stitched guidelines</p> <p>Stitch Color 2 which attaches the Batting and creates guideline for your fabrics</p>	
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	<p>Place Fabric 1 as pictured – right side facing up from the hoop.</p> <p>We use the stitch and flip method to attach Fabric 2</p> <p>Fabric 2 is placed with right-side facing the hoop,</p> <p>You want to ensure that the 2<sup>nd</sup> fabric covers the stitching line – AND will flip back and cover the Mug Rug edges</p>	
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Stitch Color 3 to attach fabrics

You can now cut away excess fabric along the seam line – leave about a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch



Flip Fabric 2 back as shown, and ensure it covers the original Mug Rug Guideline (with at least  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch extra)

Finger Press (or Iron) in place



As before,

We use the stitch and flip method to attach Fabric 3

Fabric 3 is placed with right-side facing the hoop,

You want to ensure that the 3<sup>rd</sup> fabric covers the stitching line – AND will flip back and cover the Mug Rug edges



Stitch Color 4 to attach fabrics

You can now cut away excess fabric along the seam line – leave about a ¼ inch



Flip Fabric 3 back as shown, and ensure it covers the original Mug Rug Guideline (with at least ¼ inch extra)

Finger Press (or Iron) in place



Stitch Color 5 which holds all fabrics down



Complete the detailed embroidery in your chosen thread colors:

(Skip any Color you do not want to stitch)

Color 6 – Stippling

Color 7 – Decorative Stitch

Color 8 – Decorative Stitch

Color 9 – Decorative Edge Stitch

Color 10 – Coffee Cup

Color 11 - Initial



#### ADD BACKING FABRICS



#### LAST COLOR

As pictured place the 8X5 backing with folded edge towards hoop, leaving about 1 inch Gap on the right hand side



Place the 8X3 backing  
with folded edge towards hoop, and overlapping your first  
piece by about 1 inch



Stitch Color 12 to attach all fabrics



Remove from hoop

Cutaway excess fabric

I clip the corners to help the Mug Rug sit straight

Turn to right side and press

That's it!!
